ORDINANCE NO. 2006-02**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES
OVER 9,000 POUNDS ON CITY STREETS**

The City Council of St. Augusta, Minnesota hereby ordains:

Section 1. Parking Prohibition. It is prohibited for any person or party to park a truck of over nine thousand (9,000) pounds gross vehicle weight on any street in the City of St. Augusta, unless said truck is actually engaged in making a pick up or delivery at a property abutting said street, in which case said truck may be parked on such street for a period of time not to exceed two hours provided the vehicle is parked in such a manner that allows two cars to safely pass the parked vehicle. This ordinance shall not apply to Stearns County Highways, Minnesota Trunk Highways or Federal Interstates located within the City of St. Augusta.

Section 2. Penalty

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor which shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance may also be subject to an administrative fine of \$100 per violation pursuant to City ordinance No. 2005-12, titled An Ordinance To Provide For Administrative Enforcement Of Code Regulations. Every day that the offense occurs shall be deemed a separate violation of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date

This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
