City Clean Up—Saturday, May 19

The annual City Clean Up will occur on Saturday, May 19, from 7 a.m.. until 11 a.m. here at the St. Augusta City Hall. We are in need of volunteers from the community to help with the collection. The only requirements are that individuals be 18 years of age or older, and that they be able to assist in lifting, carrying, and handling the containers brought to the collection site. Please call City Hall at 654-0387 if you are able to volunteer to help with this.

Again this year, the charge per load/trailer will be \$8.00. Additional charges apply for appliances, electronics, tires, and the like. The charge for most appliances is \$10.00; cost for tire recycling ranges from \$1.00—30.00. Contact City Hall for a complete listing or to ask for specifics. Please also note, no gas/RV refrigerators can be accepted.

Please note, the City of St. Augusta reserves the right to refuse acceptance of any items.

Hazardous waste items will not be accepted. These include: paints, cleaners, poisons, roofing tar, fuels, automotive chemicals, sealers, garden or pool chemicals, fluorescent bulbs, adhesives, aerosols, solvents, mothballs, batteries, scrap iron, and mercury and must be taken directly to the Stearns County Hazardous Waste Facility in Waite Park.

We also cannot accept: pharmaceutical or medical waste, business waste, explosives.
