ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1999-1 TITLED
“ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DOGS AND CATS FROM
RUNNING AT LARGE AND PROHIBITING VICIOUS DOGS”

The City Council of the City of St. Augusta, Stearns County, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1999-1 is hereby amended to add paragraph D as follows:

D. “Habitually Barking Dog” means any dog that (i) barks, whines, cries or makes other similar such noises for a period of five minutes or more, with less than 1 minute intervals between noises and (ii) such noises are audible off of the Owner’s property or premises, or such other property or premises upon which the dog is kept.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1999-1 is hereby amended to delete the existing text of said Section 2 and replace it with the following text:

Section 2. Noisy Animals. Habitually Barking Dogs are hereby declared a public nuisance. No owner shall keep or harbor a Habitually Barking Dog within the City of St. Augusta. An Owner of a Habitually Barking Dog shall be subject to the penalties provided in section thirteen (13) below.

Passed by the St. Augusta City Council this 2nd day of January, 2007.

This ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
