## **INSTRUCTIONS**

At or before the commencement of any new electrical wiring installation, the person responsible for making such installation shall submit to the City of St. Augusta a request for Electrical Inspection and the appropriate fee.

All forms must be signed by the electrical contractor, master electrician, installer, or owner installing the wiring.

This form must be accurately completed. It is essential that the job address portion of the form identify the geographical location of the job. This address (location) may be different than the mailing address. If this location does not have a specific street and number address, a map must be drawn on the back of the form.

All electrical wiring must be inspected before it is concealed in any manner. The electrical inspector must be notified sufficiently in advance to complete the inspection before insulating, sheetrocking, paneling, filling trenches, pouring concrete, etc. Wiring that is concealed before inspection must be exposed. Unless specific arrangements are made with the inspector, inspections are performed during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, exclusive of holidays. Inspections may be scheduled by telephone between the hours of 7:00am and 8:30am weekdays only. The person requesting the inspection must make arrangements for the inspector to gain access to the installed wiring.

Four copies of the form are needed – One for the inspector, one for the City of St. Augusta, one for the power supplier/electrical utility company and one for the property owner. *Please note there is a minimum inspection fee of \$35.00 per inspection trip.* 

The City and Inspector copies must be forwarded to the City of St. Augusta along with the appropriate inspection fee. All checks must be payable to the City of St. Augusta. The power supplier/electrical utility company copy is a certificate of affidavit that is required by law to be filed with the electrical utility company that supplies power to this installation before connection or reconnection of electrical service. The utility may require a signature at the bottom of the form.

A Request for Electrical Inspection becomes void 12 months after the filing date. It is the responsibility of the person installing the electrical wiring (electrical contractor, installer, special electrician, or owner) to schedule all the inspections, including final inspections. Electrical wiring required by the National Electrical Code must be completed before the building, space within the building, or equipment is utilized and before the expiration of the Request for Electrical Inspection. In the event that incomplete wiring is not required and a building, space within a building, or equipment is not being utilized. A new Request for Electrical Inspection must be filed with the proper inspection fee.

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
